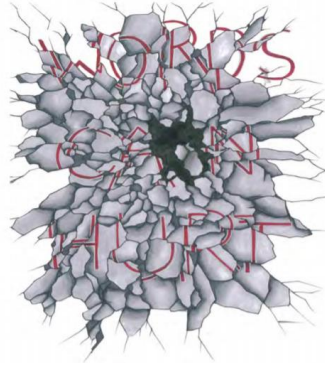
Role: Anti-Bullying Ambassador
